

FELLOWSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Marcus Garvey Foundation's *Jean Harvey Slappy Research Fellowship*

This fellowship—named in honor of Jean Harvey Slappy, a long-time board member of the Marcus Garvey Foundation—looks to support doctoral candidates working on aspects of the history of the U.N.I.A. (Universal Negro Improvement Association), the A.C.L. (African Communities League), and/or Marcus Garvey's organizational activities, and who wish to use the recently deposited Thomas W. Harvey/U.N.I.A. collection (Finding Aid: <http://bit.ly/18DC3G1>) located at Emory University's Manuscript, Archives, and Rare Book Library (MARBL). Research fellows receive grants of \$500 to help defray expenses associated with travel to and use of the archival collection.

All applications & attachments must be received before midnight on March 24, 2017
Decisions will be announced no later than May 12, 2017

While proposals are welcome on a wide variety of research topics (and in a wide variety of disciplines), proposals will be evaluated based on their relevance to key questions in the field of African and African diaspora studies and on the basis of their unique contribution to scholarship.

Required application materials:

- * 2-page summary of the larger research project (single- or double-spaced)
- * 1-page description of the specific research to be carried out with the grant (single- or double-spaced), along with a line-item budget (for up to \$500.00) and research timeline
- * Curriculum Vitae
- * One recommendation from an advising professor
